CCHA Preceptor

General Description

CCHA Preceptors will serve as supervisors and mentors during the practicum phase of the CCHA training curriculum for designated individuals seeking their community health worker certification

Job Responsibilities

- Supervise an in-field community health worker experience for individuals who have begun or advanced from the facilitated learning portion of the CCHA training program for 80 hours
- Evaluate assignments submitted by training participants
- Participate in brief preceptor-to-participant learning activities
- Identify and address learning needs of field placement/ practicum participant in preparation for exam and CHW professional experience
- Communicate anticipated areas of need or support (as a preceptor) to CCHA Training Coordinator)
- Communicate with CCHA Training Coordinator as it relates to status of practicum (tracking attendance, performance evaluation, etc.)

Minimum requirements

- 2 years of experience as a Community Health Worker
- Experience facilitating learning experiences and mentoring other professionals
- Capacity to model best practices and evaluate aspirant community health worker performance for 80 hours
- Must participate in CCHA Preceptor Training

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
